

Dryden Sealit

Water based cosolvent free waterproofer for porous substrates, ie: masonry, natural stones, concrete, brick work, pots, etc.

Prevents the damage which might otherwise occur by ingress of water.

When applied, penetrates into the substrate, when dry is virtually undetectable, preserving the original appearance and character.

PREPARATION

Surface must be dry (touch dry) and free of algae, lichen, loose materials, etc.

Obvious cracks or joints must be made good prior to treatment otherwise rain penetration may occur at these points.

Hairline cracks which are stable do not require pre-treatment.

APPLICATION

Should be liberally applied by soft nylon or shuttle brush freely in two coats, second coat should be applied immediately after the first coat has been absorbed or up to 24 hours after if cannot be avoided. Dryden Sealit can resist wash off by rain fall as soon as 1 hour after application, full waterproof properties achieved after 24 hours.

FIRST AID

If Swallowed:

If swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting. Give two glasses of water or milk to drink, do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician.

If in Eyes:

Immediately irrigate eyes continuously with copious quantities of water for 15 minutes. Ensure irrigation under eyelids by occasionally lifting eyelids. Seek medical attention if symptoms persist.

If on Skin/Hair:

If this product comes into contact with skin, wash skin with soap and water for 15 minutes. Remove contaminated clothing and footwear. Ensure contaminated clothing is thoroughly washed before use again. Seek medical advice if irritation persists.

If Inhaled:

If fumes or combustion products are inhaled, remove to fresh air. Lay victim down and keep warm and rested. If breathing is shallow, or has stopped, ensure clear airway and apply resuscitation or oxygen if available. Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician.
